LEVELS OF CARE AT THE INPATIENT CENTER

General Inpatient Care (GIP): For patients requiring advanced medical and nursing care for symptoms unmanageable at home—such as uncontrolled pain, severe shortness of breath, or seizures. The goal is short-term stabilization to facilitate a transition back to the patient’s prior setting.

Respite Care: Provides families a break from the rigors of home caregiving. Patients may transfer to the inpatient center for up to five days while loved ones rest.

Routine or “Residential” Care: For patients who do not require GIP or respite care but choose to live at the inpatient center until end-of-life.

FAQs

Q: Who is the Inpatient Center for?

Any hospice patient with symptoms or care needs that are difficult to manage. Families, physicians, or your care team can make a referral.

Q: When should we consider the Inpatient Center?

Consider it when symptoms like pain, nausea, or extreme restlessness become hard to manage at home. Our team can help you decide if it is the right time.

Q: Is care at the Inpatient Center covered by insurance?

General Inpatient and Respite care are covered by the Medicare Hospice Benefit, Medicaid, and many private plans. Routine/Residential care is private pay for Room & Board and subject to bed availability.

Q: Can family visit?

Yes. Visitors of all ages –and pets, with approval –are welcome around the clock. While here, this is the patient’s home.

Q: How is this different from a hospital?

Our care prioritizes comfort and quality of life. We avoid unnecessary tests and procedures, focusing entirely on the patient’s goals.
